	Two candidates were introduced to the Council. Bob Woodward, former Councillor and Richard Sellers Cllr Lawton and Cllr Watson nominated Bob Woodward and Richard Sellers as prospective Councillors. All Councillors agreed. Cllr Woodward and Cllr Sellers were duly co-opted onto the Council. Declarations of office were given to the Clerk.

	Cllr Humby – Assured the Council that if he was not present at meetings he was still working for the community and sometimes there were other meetings that clashed with Council meetings. 16 <sup>th</sup> November – Highway and transport workshops – Proposing the road traffic survey for the whole area – LLP2 Colden Common, Twyford and other parishes could get funding from \$106 if any development were to go ahead. It was important to gain current data to use as a benchmark to monitor traffic changes with any development. Broadband – Cllr Humby had met the officers dealing with the Broadband rollout. There would still be a lot of help needed for areas that weren't included in initial rollout and they were currently looking at funding. Some areas looking at community buy in. Encourage to look at the website for updates on areas and on their current status. Rural Services network conference – Affordable housing, Broadband and Health ( Social isolation) Cllr Humby had been made the Member for Rural affairs. Combined Authority – This was an option that was currently being considered but it was at a very early stage. Does not mean a loss of control but actually gaining powers such as Highways etc. Control of rates possibly, improved training etc. It is hoped that then this would attract more funding. A lot of negotiation still ahead and would be unlikely to occur before 2017. Rural Coordination group – Raise awareness of any issues within rural part of Hampshire. Town and Country Planning agenda – Rural affordable housing. Children and Young Peoples select committee – Funding for rural schools – frozen in 2013 and lobby to change the balance. Whitely 3500 houses –Postponed decision and developer making changes in areas of concern. Crossing – Waiting for Southern Electricity. Community Support Grant – Still open for applications.
