5.	What is the purpose or project for which the grant is requested?	Twyford Tots provides a weekly space for families to play and relax with toys, tea and cake provided. We charge a nominal £2 per family, which goes towards renting the village hall. As a community group we keep our charges to a minimum to ensure all families are able to attend and use this mid-week session for enjoyment, support and networking. We are requesting a grant to update and replace broken equipment in our role play area to ensure that the children have a high quality experience while at the group. Role play is vital in young children to promote independence, risk taking, communication and language skills and social skills. We are also looking to purchase a badge maker for creative use and at fundraising events to help raise funds. This is a resource that could be used by many different local community groups such as Twyford Playgroup, Rainbows, Brownies and Guides and Twyford St Mary's. <i>See notes at end for a break down of equipment to be purchased.</i>
6		We have used some of our limited reserves to take advantage of a discount on the role play toys. All other items would ideally be purchased
